We booked a hotel near the Eiffel Tower. We booked a river cruise **as well**.

I joined the math club. I joined the science club **as well**.

I cleaned the kitchen. I vacuumed the living room **as well**.

##### Call it a day

Meaning: To stop working on something.

Example: "We've done a lot of work on the report. Let's **call it a day** and continue tomorrow."

"We've finished the main tasks for today. Shall we **call it a day**?"

#### in addition

Our sales increased by 15% this quarter. **In addition**, customer satisfaction has improved significantly.

Our product is more efficient than that of our competitors. **Furthermore**, it is made from 100% recycled materials.

The tenant failed to pay rent on time. **Furthermore**, they violated the noise policy.
