Example: Those best friends are like two peas in a pod; they do everything together.

We get along like two peas in a pod, sharing the same interests and hobbies.

We need to review the data **before** making any conclusions.

**Before** addressing the main issue, let's consider the background information.

#### after

After explaining the background, we will move on to the main argument.

Please summarize the key points after you finish your presentation.

After evaluating the evidence, we can draw a reasonable conclusion.
