2. track 17 telephone (5)

Operator: Bus travel information, this is Janice. How can I help you?

Woman: Hi. I was calling, *I am visiting Manhattan and I need to get to Jones Beach this Saturday to see a concert.*

Operator: Okay.

Woman: And I don't have a car. *I was wondering if there was public transportation that I could take.*

Operator: From Manhattan, this is just bus information, but from Manhattan what you can do is you could take the Long Island Railroad from Penn Station.

Woman: Yes.

Operator: To Freeport.

Woman: Okay.

Operator: And then at the Freeport Station, you'll take a bus, a JB62, the bus that will take you to the Jones Beach Theater.

Woman: Okay. And then, do I just get off the train and the buses run regularly?

Operator: The bus is down.... The bus is right downstairs from the train station. Okay. The first bus that will take you to the theater is at 6:30.

Woman : And then *how frequently do they run* after that?

Operator: After that , there's a bus at 6:30, 7:20, 8:10. That'll take you to the theater. When the concert is over, there are dispatchers at the theater to make sure that there is a bus till about a

half-hour after the concert's over to take you back to Freeport.

Woman: Okay. And there will definitely be a train still running when I get back to Freeport?

Operator: You'll have to check with the railroad as far as the railroad timetable.

Woman: Okay. And *can you give me a fare for the bus*, please?

Operator: Sure, the fare for the bus is \$1.50. *It can be paid in coins* or you can use a Metro Card.

Woman: Okay.

Operator: Also, um, the railroad offers a package, called the Long island Gateway, for \$11 from Penn Station. It's the railroad and the bus fare.

Woman: And that is one, one way or round trip?

Operator: No, it's round trip.

Woman: Okay.

Operator: Okay?

Woman: Thank you very much.

Operator: You're welcome.

Woman: Bye-bye.
